Dear Parents & Friends

At the last family camp in 2008 over 50 families joined us on family camp, so **BOOK EARLY** to guarantee your place.

Date & Venue: 28th-30th May

Arrive **Saturday at 12pm** and depart **Monday around 11am** after the closing ceremony at Walton Firs Campsite, Cobham. A pre-camp meeting is on Thurs 19th May 7:15pm at the Scout Hall - a must for all first time campers.

Typical Activities (if you want to):

Abseiling & Climbing, Archery, Air-Rifle Shooting, Orienteering, Maze, Adventure Course, pioneering, rounders, volleyball, cricket, to name a few & campfire too. After the campfire there will be a wide game, followed by a social gathering in the hut or around the fire for adults.

Who Can Come?

The camp is open to all 3rd Hampton Hill members and their families. All children must bring an adult or two. You are responsible for your children at all times whilst on this camp. The leadership team are there to run the camp.

What do you need?

A recommended kit list and programme will be issued to those who are joining us. However, each family needs a tent - if you do not have one, we can lend some on a first come first served basis. You will need to ask Richard Moody to ensure availability. This will cost £20 to cover tent maintenance.

Cost:

£30/adult £25/child (16-8 yrs) £20/child (7-6yrs) £10/child (5 & under) Family £100 (2 adults & up to 4 children)

What is provided?

8 hours of various activities, Saturday supper, Sunday breakfast, lunch and dinner, Monday breakfast and lots of tea, coffee, squash & biscuits. (Please note that meals can only be provided if we have volunteers).

To all **adults** - you may supply your own alcohol; however site rules dictate that it must only be consumed on our site & after 6:30pm.

Regulations say all adults (18+) have to be **CRB'd** (security cleared by the Scout Movement). The forms are available from your section leader. Without this clearance you will be unable to join us on camp.

We must have all replies and completed CRB forms back by **25th March 2011**. If you have any further queries please contact your section leader.
